Sub: Grant of conditional permission to the KLE University, Shri B.M. Kankanwadi Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya Post Graduate Studies and Research Centre, Belgaum, Shahapur, Belgavi Karnataka with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course seats for the academic session 2019-20 under section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970- reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order No. R.17011/44/2018-EP (IM-1) dated 06.09.2018 related to admission matter for the year 2018-19 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for the academic session 2019-20.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 27-28.02.2019 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry. On examining the same, it was observed that the said college is fulfilling all the norms for granting conditional permission (permission for a period of one year) for the academic year 2019-20, as per sub-regulation (3) of regulation 3 of RMS, 2016, IMCC Post graduate (Ayurveda) regulations, 2016 and as per approved Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs).

3. It has been decided by the Central Government to grant conditional permission KLE University, Shri B.M. Kankanwadi Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya Post Graduate Studies and Research Centre, Belgaum, Shahapur, Belgavi Karnataka with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2019-20 under section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 (Permission regarding PG seats will be issued separately) subject to following conditions:

- The college shall submit an undertaking in form of affidavit duly notarized within one month from the date of issue of this letter explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

- ii. The colleges shall submit undertaking in the form of Affidavit duly notarized to get permanent registration of the Teachers/Hospital Clinical Staff/Consultant in concerned State Boards/Council where the college/hospital is located or Central Registration of the CCIM by 31st December, 2019 as per the decisions conveyed vide letters 22.03.2019 & 22.04.2019 by CCIM and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant/denial of permission for the academic year 2020-21.
4. It is further informed that 100% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 UG seats shall be treated as all India quota for deemed University as they are all India in nature. The counseling for seats under all India quotas shall be conducted by the Central Government. If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the concerned deemed University to admit students as per rules/norms decided by central government. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the Central counseling for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
5. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under IMCC Act & Regulations made thereunder.
6. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCIM and the Central Government.
7. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2019 to get conditional permission for the session 2020-21:
- (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
 - (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*; and
 - (iv) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 for grant of permission to PG courses.
8. The fulfillment of the above mentioned conditions will be verified by the CCIM by means of an inspection and CCIM will submit a report along with its assessment in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2020-21.
9. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
